## AN ESSENTIAL & HIGHLY INFLUENTIAL PROGRAMME

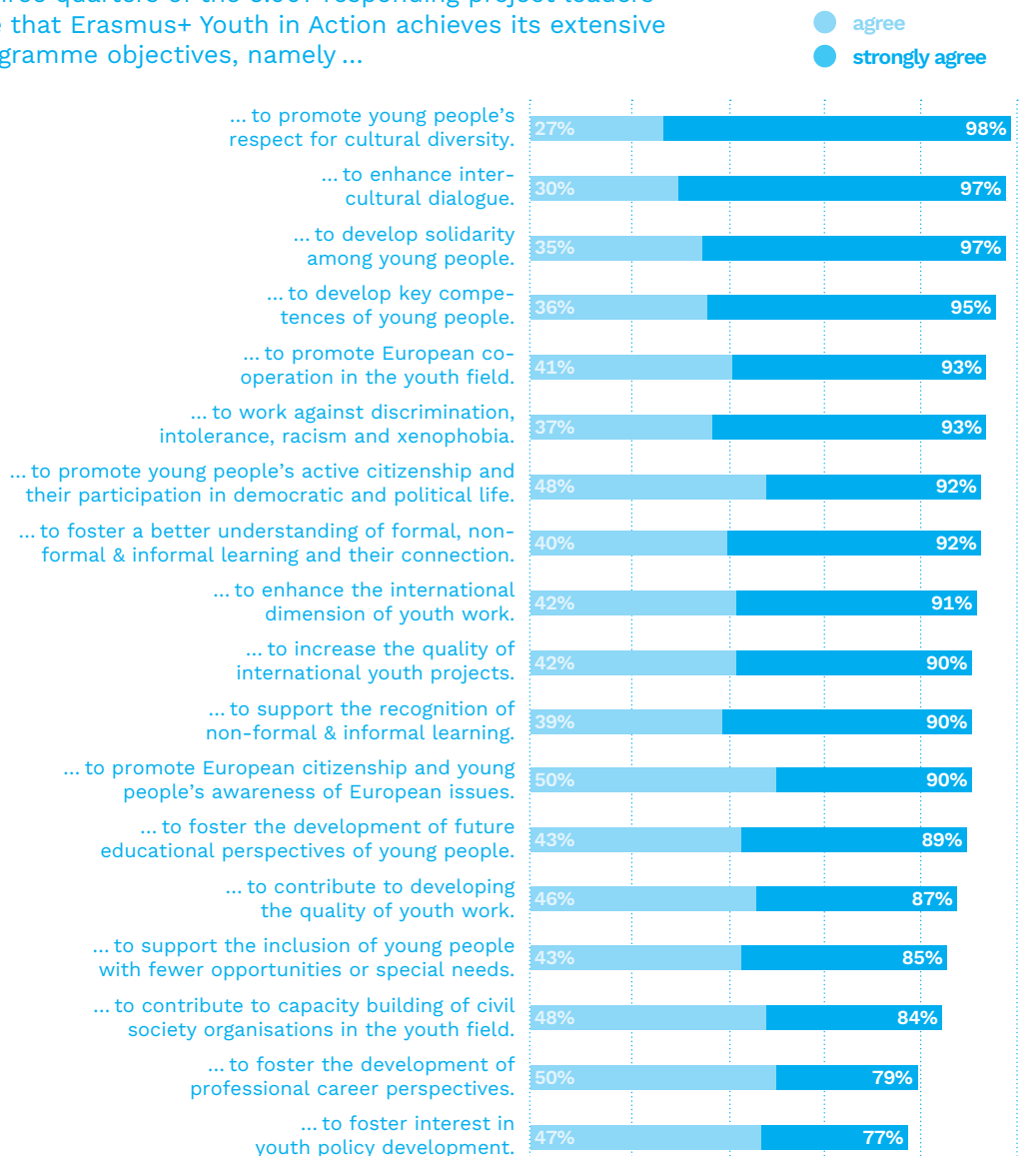

The programme promotes intercultural dialogue, non-formal learning, equity and inclusion<sup>1</sup>. It has a wide range of policy and programme objectives. Our research shows that Erasmus+ Youth in Action is successful in achieving its objectives and contributes substantively to **"making the most of youth policy's potential"** and **"fostering youth participation in democratic life"**, the core ambition and overarching objective<sup>2</sup> of the EU Youth Strategy 2019–2027.
