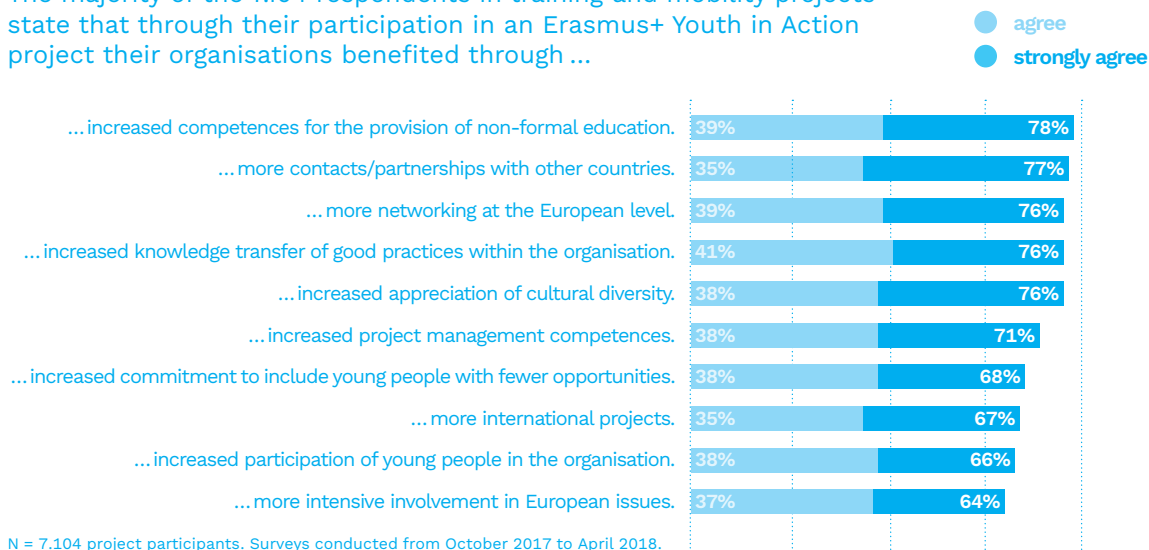

Erasmus+ Youth in Action is the European Union's learning mobility programme for young people and youth work organisations, institutions and professionals. The programme promotes intercultural dialogue, non-formal learning, equity and inclusion¹. One specific objective is to foster quality development in youth work. Our research shows that Erasmus+ Youth in Action is successful in achieving this objective and contributes to **“actively engaging youth organisations in the development, implementation and evaluation of policies affecting the lives of young people”**, one of the key principles² of the EU Youth Strategy 2019–2027.

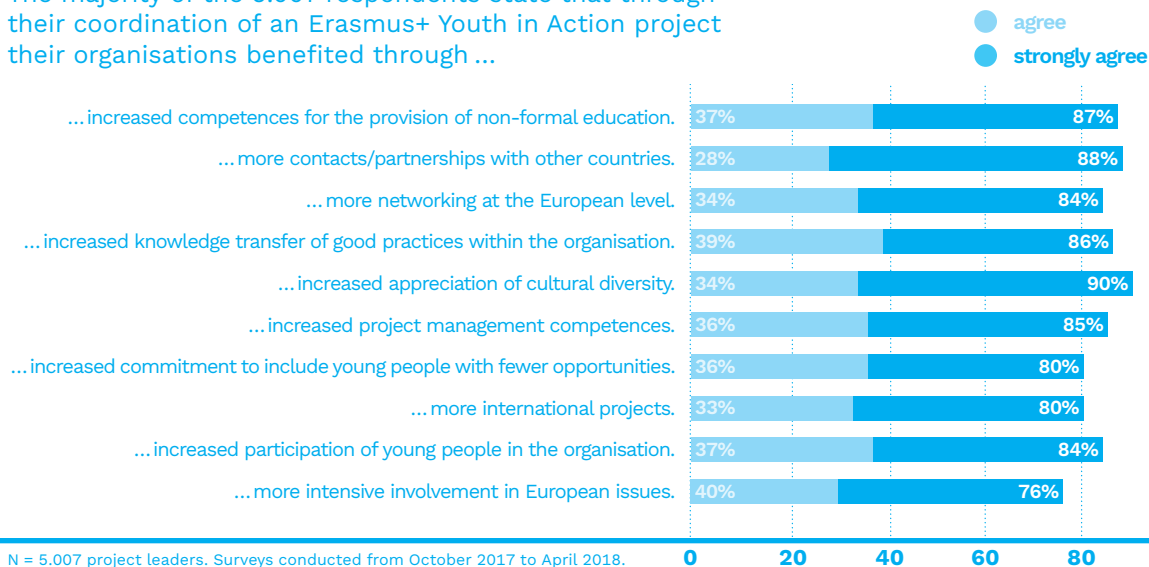
Effects on youth organisations of project participants
